



## New Term

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Dear Parents,

Thank you for supporting us as your children settled into Nursery School. You all did a great job of preparing the children for school. We all understand that this can be a very difficult time if children are distressed but fortunately the children are all happily getting used to the routines.



## Security

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Thank you for remembering to keep the gates closed. We appreciate your help in keeping the children safe. Please remember that we close the door at 8.35am and 12.35pm **promptly** and if the red door is closed you will need to enter through the main entrance in Horrell Road.

This is vital in keeping your children safe and secure. May we remind you that the gate must not be left open for parents who are close to, but not yet at the gate.

Installation of a new security gate is almost complete. This is between the main gate on Horrell Road and the entrance to the building. If you arrive late a member of staff will open the gate for you. This provides us with an even greater level of security.

Whilst you enter the Nursery with your child any member of staff at the door will care for younger children in pushchairs. This avoids the need to take them out of the pushchair. Please 'park' the pushchair close to the door but not blocking the entrance.

Thank you.

Empty pushchairs should not be left at the door but should be parked in the buggy shelter.

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## Attendance & Punctuality

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Thank you all for bringing your children to school on time each day. We understand that it can be difficult to get three year-olds here on time and we appreciate the efforts you have made.

We are judged by OFSTED on our attendance figures and we also feel that good routines are essential. For the children, missing the start of sessions also affects their learning and their opportunity to be chosen as a helper and other chances to develop social skills.

Thank you, too, for contacting us if your child is unwell. It is essential that we have this information. We will be putting a small fob in your child's drawer which will give you the school contact details.



## School Uniform

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The children all look lovely in their new uniform. Thank you.

Unfortunately, when all the children take off their coats we have a real problem with matching the coat to the child when their coats aren't named. Please may we ask you to name all uniform, jumpers, polo shirts and coats particularly.

## School Fund

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Several parents have paid their School Fund for the entire school year or for a term. We are grateful to parents for this contribution and are happy to accept payments weekly, half-termly, termly or yearly.

Thank you also to the parents who have made large single contributions to the school or additional weekly payments. These are very much appreciated.
