A few months ago, I was approached by some of our parents and carers who were surprised that Garretts Green Nursery School has no Parent-Teacher Association and who were eager to establish a supporting group for the school. After exploring the options, we finally met as a small group last week and now have plans in place to establish a PTA which will be known as 'Happy Families'.

There will be many benefits to the school and to our families; developing close relationships between home and school, providing support for the school at times of increased workload (Christmas, trips, events) and fund-raising.

Initially, I would like to keep the leading group reasonably small until such a time as we have become confident with the practicalities and the legal and financial conditions of running such a group.

However, if any of you is happy to commit time and energy to being part of the Happy Families lead group we would be pleased for you to join us.

If you are interested in being involved on a more flexible ad-hoc basis to help out at events when you are available but without any commitment, again, we would be grateful for your support.

Our initial discussions have been around a launch of Happy Families at our **Phonics and Maths Family Workshop** on **Tuesday 14th March**. A Cake Sale and a Bring and Buy will be held during the Workshop and we hope that you will contribute cakes and other items that we could sell. Please come along to the Workshop to spend some time with your child, to see what we do in school and, at the same time, to raise money for the school. More details to follow.

Our big event for the summer term will be the celebration for the 70th Anniversary of Garretts Green Nursery School to be held on Friday 7thJuly and Saturday 8thJuly. Again, further details to follow.

Primary School Places

Parents will be notified of Primary School place allocations on 18th April by email or on 19th April by letter.

You will then need to accept the place formally by contacting the school allocated to your child. Failure to accept the place may result in that place being lost. This must be completed no later than 5th May

SCHOOL GATES and PARKING

Many of our parents leave our school to take older children to primary schools in the morning or to collect older children at the end of the day and we understand that there are problems about time and parking.

However, I must stress that, even when you are in a hurry, it takes just a second to close our gate and doing so would not delay you.

It also takes just a second for a child to run ahead of parents as they leave and for them to dash through an open gate.

This is a safeguarding issue and I must request that every parents or carer visiting the site remembers to close the gate immediately, sliding the bolt at the top to ensure that children cannot reach up and open it.

There have been several complaints from neighbours regarding parking around the school site. Please may I ask you to ensure that you park carefully, avoiding obstructions to driveways.

It has also been brought to my attention that parents are parking very close to the bus stop in Garretts Green Lane which is causing concerns for the safety of bus passengers trying to leave or board the buses. In addition, if the bus cannot pull in, it causes an obstruction for the traffic in this busy road.

Please help us to keep all our children safe!
