Before School Breakfast Club

We are offering a breakfast club from 8.25-8.55 am at a cost of £2 per session, payable half termly in advance.

After School Club

If a 3.00pm collection causes you some difficulties, why not consider After School Club? We are running an after-school provision from 2.55pm to 3.30pm for children who are eligible for a 30 hour place currently at a cost of £2 per session, at a cost of £2 per session payable half termly in advance.

REMINDER 30 HOUR CODES

Please can I remind all of the parents receiving the 30 hours funded childcare that the code will need to be renewed every <u>three months</u> otherwise your eligibility may stop. Childcare Choices should send you an email to remind you, but it maybe worth you checking when your code is due for renewal.

Could we please ask parents to let Trish know when the code has been renewed. Thank you.

Parental Consultations

During the second week after half term, we will be holding our Parental Consultations. These are extremely important meetings about your child's attainment and how he or she has settled in school. You are all urged to attend.

Each Family Group (Colour Group) has a specific date for consultations, details below. In addition, we also offer one after-school consultation for parents who are unable to attend during the day on:

After School Consultation : Monday 12th November 2018 3.45-5.30.

Should you have any concerns regarding your child's attainment or progress, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's Key Worker or Claire, and we will be happy to answer any questions you may have.

Monday 12th November : Green Group, morning and afternoon appointments

Tuesday 13th November: Yellow Group, morning and afternoon appointments

<u>Thursday 15th November:</u> Orange Group, morning appointments only and Blue afternoon appointments only

Appointments will be available for booking at the beginning of October. Sheets will be with each Key Worker. Please sign up early to ensure that you are able to book a convenient appointment. Thank you.

<u>Attendance</u>

We were all very pleased with the attendance of the children across the Nursery during the first few weeks of the new term. Thank you.

We do appreciate that this is your child's first year in school and that they will be mixing with large numbers of other children who share germs! If your child is ill, the best place to be is at home but please remember to:

- Phone school on the first day of absence so that we know your child is ill and what the illness is.
- Let us know if your child has a contagious illness such as chicken pox (it may be necessary to inform parents as some childhood illnesses may be dangerous during pregnancy).
- Tell us if your child has a more serious illness such as measles.
- Keep your child at home until the illness has subsided. There are different guidelines for different illnesses so please ask for advice when you call us.
- Vomiting and diarrhoea always requires 48 hours at home after the last bout.

<u>Absence for Holidays</u>

Several parents have asked me what they should do about holidays during the school term which were booked prior to their child starting at Nursery.

There is an expectation that all children will be in school every day. However, if you have booked a holiday and your child is likely to be absent from Nursery school please ask a member of staff for the appropriate document to fill in.

I must stress that I am no longer allowed to **authorise** any absence due to holidays in term-time and your child's holiday will be recorded as unauthorised. Please try to avoid booking holidays in term-time if possible. Thank you for your support.

<u>Tapestry</u>

In order for you to be able to see and add to your child's on-line learning journey via Tapestry, please if you haven't already email the address below with your name, your child's name and colour Group. This will then ensure that your secure access can be set up.

You will be able to see what your child has been doing in Nursery and also to add photographs or make comments on the posted observations by teachers.

My First Week in Nursery School

Our Forest School sessions begin next week when the children will be introduced to the rules of Forest School . They will try on the waterproof clothing and practice changing into wellies.

Please make sure that your child has wellies in school from now on so that their feet stay dry. On your child's coat peg there is a wellies bag, this should not be taken home. Wellies should be named and placed in a plastic bag inside the fabric bag.

If the weather is very wet or very cold, we occasionally need to work indoors. We continue to work outdoors in most weather conditions but when temperatures are extreme we have found that the children often become distressed. We usually offer activities that support the Forest School philosophy on these occasions.
