# Before School Breakfast Club / After School Club

We offer a breakfast club from 8.25-8.55 am at a cost of  $\pm 2$  per session. Please let us know if you would like to use this facility, either regularly or on the odd occasion.

If a 3.00pm collection causes you some difficulties, why not consider After School Club? We also run an after-school provision from 2.55pm to 3.30pm at a cost of £2 per session for children who are eligible for a 30 hour place. Please let us know if you would like to make use of this. ## **REMINDER 30 HOUR CODES**

Please can we remind all of the parents receiving the 30 hours funded childcare that the code will need to be renewed **every <u>three months</u> otherwise your eligibility may stop**. Childcare Choices should send you an email to remind you, but it maybe worth you checking when your code is due for renewal.

This applies whether you have a 30 hour full time place or if you split your 30 hours with another provider e.g. a childminder or private nursery. Please make sure that you have informed us if you are splitting your hours with another setting / childminder.

# <u>Parental Consultations</u>

You are all urged to attend, we ask however, that **no children attend if possible** in order that staff are able to talk to parents / carers freely.

Appointments will be available for booking at the beginning of next week. Sheets will be with each Key Worker. Please sign up early to ensure that you are able to book a convenient appointment. Thank you.

# <u>Attendance</u>

We were all very pleased with the attendance of the children across the Nursery during the first few weeks of the new term. Thank you.

We do appreciate that this is your child's first year in school and that they will be mixing with large numbers of other children who share germs! If your child is ill, the best place to be is at home but please remember to:

- Phone school or email (enquiry@garretts.bham.sch.uk) on the first day of absence so that we know your child is ill and what the illness is.
- Let us know if your child has a contagious illness such as chicken pox (it may be necessary to inform parents as some childhood illnesses may be dangerous during pregnancy).
- Tell us if your child has a more serious illness such as measles.
- Keep your child at home until the illness has subsided. There are different guidelines for different illnesses so please ask for advice when you call us.
- Vomiting and diarrhoea always requires 48 hours at home after the last bout.

# <u>Absence for Holidays</u>

Several parents have asked me what they should do about holidays during the school term which were booked prior to their child starting at Nursery.

There is an expectation that all children will be in school every day. However, if you have booked a holiday and your child is likely to be absent from Nursery school please ask a member of staff for the appropriate document to fill in.

I must stress that I am no longer allowed to **authorise** any absence due to holidays in term-time and your child's holiday will be recorded as unauthorised. Please try to avoid booking holidays in term-time if possible. Thank you for your support.

Please could you make sure that you have returned all of your permission forms and the pink funding form, we may be unable to have your child in Nursery if we do not receive the forms. Thank you.
