We would like to say how proud we are of all the children. They have settled so well and are loving all the new learning opportunities, exploring all the nursery environment and developing friendships.

Please remember you can always talk to your child's key worker if you have any questions or concerns. We are here to help and support you on your child's learning journey.

We have been advised by Birmingham Children's Hospital's that the Emergency Department has been under significant, sustained pressure due to high levels of respiratory infections locally and unprecedented attendances. Across the country, Children's EDs are seeing approximately a 20% increase on previous record attendances, with a number of units reporting a lack of beds for paediatric admissions. We know that many children haven't been exposed to 'classroom environments' due to the pandemic.

Oasis Hobmoor Community Centre- The Living Room





Parking.

The lack of parking space around school has increasingly been a cause for some concern and I would like to thank you for your cooperation as you try to find a place to leave your car but may we urge you to park safely and considerately when you arrive to drop off your child or at the end of the session.

When you park near school please may I therefore ask you to consider the following:

- √Parking on the pavement is an offence and you may be subject to a fine but parking entirely on the pavement also prevents safe access to the school gate
- ✓ Visibility is also restricted for traffic using the road and drivers may not see little children. behind parked cars
- \checkmark Parking on zig-zag lines outside the Horrell Road entrance is prohibited

Our priority will always be safety and I am sure that you will help us to keep everyone safe by being considerate when parking. Thank you.
