

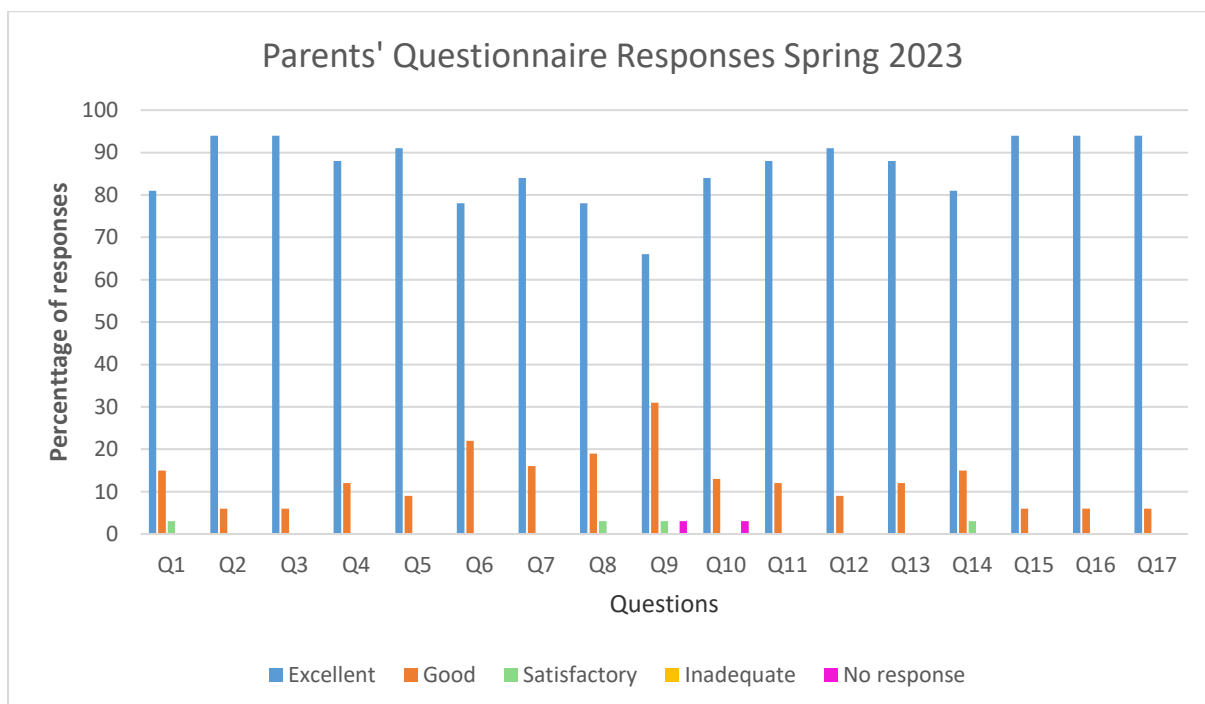
Spring Parent Questionnaire Analysis

Intent of questionnaire

The intent of this questionnaire was to ‘check in’ with parents to ensure we had an up to date understanding of their opinions and views, whilst giving them another opportunity to express their thoughts and feelings. Valuing parent partnership highly we are always keen to explore ways we can continue to improve this.

Questions Asked

1. Do we provide you with enough information about our school? <i>(eg OFSTED, Quality Mark. Quality Assurance -on website, Tapestry and in newsletters, policies, emails etc.)</i>
2. Is your child happy at Garretts Green Nursery School?
3. How welcoming and friendly is the Nursery?
4. How well do you feel able to communicate with Nursery staff?
5. Do you feel that your child is well looked-after by the School?
6. Are you well-informed about your child's learning? <i>Tapestry, Parents' Consultation)</i>
7. Are you pleased with the progress your child is making?
8. Are you pleased with Tapestry, your child's on-line learning journey?
9. Do you receive advice from us about how you can support learning at home? <i>(e.g.: Policies, Newsletters, Tapestry etc.)</i>
10. Do you feel that your child is kept safe? <i>(e.g.: secure site, staffing numbers, well-being and care)</i>
11. Is learning stimulating and fun for your child?
12. Do you feel valued and involved as a parent in Nursery?
13. If you have attended events have you felt welcome?
14. Does Home Reading appeal to you and your child?
15. Is the school well-managed?
16. What is the overall level of satisfaction with the Nursery?
17. Would you recommend our school to prospective parents?

Implementation – Moving forward

- Having two staff members participating in Makaton training there will be lots of new signs covered in Nursery. To ensure parents can keep up to date with the signs of the week we will publish them on Tapestry with a video of a staff member completing the sign to support parents in signing them at home.
- During Welcome Time the children will be shown the same video to encourage them to share this with their parents/families at home.
- Memos to continue to be published on Tapestry to sign post parents to events, advice etc. available.
- Memo to be published on Tapestry to further guide parents to our website where lots of information is regarding policies, newsletters etc.
- Staff to continue to monitor and encourage parents input on Tapestry.
- Seek and encourage more detailed comments from specific parents upon reflection of this questionnaire
- Development of new PTA will support families in sharing their thoughts and ideas to further strengthen parent partnership.
- Steering group created for Rights Respecting School project to embed rights and continue to value parents/families and their support.
- Regular coffee mornings to start once a month for any parents and families of Nursery children to attend.
- Workshops to continue as planned to involve parents and give them an opportunity to see first-hand how and what their children learn as part of their daily Nursery session.

Impact – Checking in

- Discuss and implement during SLT meetings any thoughts/ideas brought up from coffee mornings, PTA and Rights Respecting Schools meetings.
- Workshops to be evaluated and detailed comments to be encouraged.
- Summer parental consultation to be completed.
- Parents summer questionnaire to be given out and completed.
