<u>Self help skills:</u> We have been learning lots of self help and personal hygiene skills this term. Please help continuing to practice these skills over the half term holiday to develop independence further. You can do this by encouraging children to put coats and shoes on by themselves, wiping own noses, washing hands and using the toilet independently.

<u>Primary School Places for September 2024:</u> If your child will be 4 before the end of August 2024 then **you must** apply for a primary school place for them ready for next September. Applications are now open and the deadline is **15th January 2024**.


